Shida Scholarship Program

Guidance for Scholars

Scholars selected for this scholarship program agree to keep the following in mind and to abide by them.

[Distribution of Scholarship and Payment Method]

- After arriving to the US/Canada/UK, the scholarship recipient shall open a bank account in his/her own name in the country a recipient will be staying, and report the bank name, account number, and other banking information to Kyodai Collaborative as soon as possible.
- Upon receipt of the account information from the scholarship recipient, Kyodai Collaborative will wire transfer the first-year scholarship funds to the recipient's local bank account.

However, for those who wish to have the funds deposited to the recipient's bank account in Japan, the scholarship will be paid in Japanese yen based on the exchange rate at the time of transfer.

• For the payment of the second year of study abroad, the same amount as for the first year will be wire transferred on the same month one year after the start of study abroad.

[Reporting Obligations]

< Obligations to report during and after the scholarship program >

- Scholars shall report in writing to Kyodai Collaborative once a year on the results of your studies or research. If the report is not submitted by the due date, the scholarship may be suspended.
- At the end of the scholarship period, a final report throughout the scholarship period shall be submitted.

< Obligations to report on Acquisition of Degree >

• The scholarship recipients who pursued for Ph.D. program must promptly submit to Kyodai Collaborative a document certifying the Ph.D. degree (copy accepted) after they finished their studies and earned Ph.D. degree.

[Notifying Obligations]

Scholars shall notify Kyodai Collaborative as soon as possible if the following change has occurred.

<ltems which require notifications>

- When there is a change in local address or contact information in the US/Canada/UK.
- When there is a change in the enrollment status at university or research institution. (e.g., change of university or laboratory.)

<Notifications for full return to Japan>

• Upon finishing scholarship period and will fully returning to Japan, notify Kyodai Collaborative beforehand. If a recipient continues his/her studies and research after the end of the scholarship period, and decides to return to Japan afterwards, notify Kyodai Collaborative in the same manner.

[Duration and Grounds for Termination and Suspension of Scholarship]

1. Duration

The scholarship period lasts until the duration of each types of scholarship program, but if a scholars wishes to continue with his/her research and request for receiving scholarship, Kyodai Collaborative may approve of extending scholarship period for another year, confirming his/her study and research results abroad.

2. Suspension

The scholarship may be suspended if any of the following events occur;

- \cdot When a certain level of results in research has not been achieved.
- · When it is deemed difficult to obtain a doctoral degree.
- · Failure to submit reports to the Kyodai Collaboration

3. Intermission

Scholarship payments may be suspended in the event of a temporarily leave of absence or prolonged absence from the university or research institution.

4. Abolition

The scholarship will be discontinued in the following cases;

- When a student is judged to be unable to fulfill the purpose of study abroad due to illness, injury, etc.
- \cdot When a student's conduct or academic performance becomes poor.

- When the scholarship recipient receives a disciplinary action that may result in the loss of his/her student status at the university or research institution.
- When a scholarship recipient is found to have engaged in any other conduct unbecoming a scholarship recipient.

[Participation in Exchange Event and Continuation of Relationship]

<After the Scholarship Period>

Scholars who have completed their study abroad program and have returned to Japan shall keep the following matters in mind and cooperate with the activities and development of the Kyodai Collaborative and Kyoto University.

- ① Participate to the extent possible, in social gatherings and other events organized by Kyodai Collaborative.
- 2 Continue to maintain ties with Kyoto University and the Kyodai Collaborative.
- ③ Keep Kyodai Collaborative informed and updated with their address and contact information.
